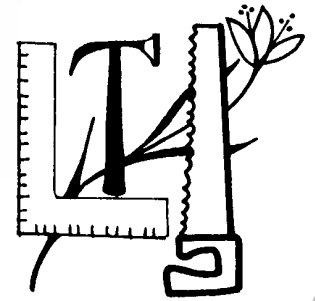

Did you know...

Saint Stanislaus of Cracow, Poland born of noble parents, he eventually became preacher to the Bishop of Cracow and was a much sought after spiritual advisor. By 1072 as Bishop of Cracow he denounced King Boleslaus the Bold for his cruelties and injustices, especially for the King's kidnapping of a beautiful wife of a nobleman. Stanislaus excommunicated the King and stopped services when he entered the Cathedral. Later, on April 11, Boleslaus killed Stanislaus himself outside of a chapel where he had been saying Mass. He was canonized by Pope Innocent IV in 1253. You can visit the Shrine Church of St. Stanislaus in Cleveland's historic Slavic Village where they still have a Sunday Mass in Polish.

THE JUBILEE YEAR OF MERCY

Pope Francis' General Audience: Being Greater Than Our Sins:



Dear Brothers and Sisters:

In our continuing catechesis for this Holy Year of Mercy, we now conclude our treatment of the Old Testament with a consideration of Psalm 51, the Miserere. This Psalm is traditionally seen as King David's prayer for forgiveness following his sin with Bathsheba. Its opening words: "Have mercy on me, O God in your kindness", are a moving confession of sin, repentance and confident hope in God's merciful pardon. Together with a heartfelt plea to be cleansed and purified of his sin, the Psalmist sings the praise of God's infinite justice and holiness. He asks for the forgiveness of his great sin but also for the gift of a pure heart and a steadfast spirit, so that, thus renewed, he may draw other sinners back to the way of righteousness. God's forgiveness is the greatest sign of his infinite mercy. Through the prayers of Mary, Mother of Mercy, may we become ever more convincing witnesses to that divine mercy which forgives our sins, creates in us a new heart, and enables us to proclaim God's reconciling love to the world. see zenit.org
