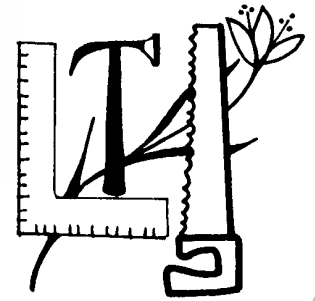

Did you know...

...the Christ the Redeemer statue in Brazil is the largest art-deco style statue in the world? It stands 98 feet tall, Jesus' outstretched arms span 92 feet atop Mt. Corcovado and can be seen anywhere in the city. It was the work of Polish-French designer Paul Landowski and Brazilian engineer Heitor da Silva Costa. A cornerstone was laid on April 4, 1922, to commemorate the centennial of Brazil's independence from Portugal. Construction began in 1926 and took five years. It was dedicated on October 12, 1931.

All funds were raised privately, mostly through the archdiocese of Rio and the Catholics of Brazil. In 2007 it was named one of the New Seven Wonders of the World.
