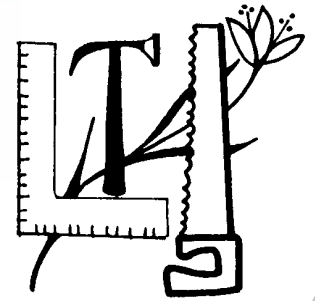

### GENERAL AUDIENCE:

**'In His infinite mercy, He is always ready to meet us wherever we are.'**



Dear Brothers and Sisters:

In our continuing catechesis for this Holy Year of Mercy, we now turn to Jesus' parable of the Good Shepherd. The Lord uses the image of the shepherd who leaves his flock to go in search of one lost sheep to express God's closeness to sinners. God does not want even a single person to be lost. In His infinite mercy, He is always ready to meet us wherever we are. The example of the Good Shepherd also challenges us to go out in search of those in particular need of God's mercy, especially those who have gone astray. Jesus teaches us that in His eyes there are no lost sheep, but only sheep needing to be found. The joy which the Good Shepherd feels must also be the joy of the entire flock. For all of us are lost sheep who were found by the Lord's mercy. All of us are called to rejoice in His merciful love, to bring that love to others and thus to join Him in gathering into the fold all those whom He wishes to save.
