July 15 & 16, 2017**



During the weekend of July 15 & 16, Reverend Francis Tandoh, CSSp, will visit our parish to speak at the Masses about the missionary work of the church and in particular about the Spiritans (Congregation of the Holy Spirit, formerly known as Holy Ghost Fathers).

The visit is part of a national program in which annually a representative of one of the mission groups visits parishes of the Diocese to invite the parish to share in the mission work of the universal Church. The Spiritans are an international community engaged in a wide range of missionary activity in over 60 countries around the world. Fr. Tandoh himself is from Ghana. He serves as pastor of several Spiritan parishes in Dayton.

When Jesus said, "You shall witness to me in Jerusalem and in Samaria and to the ends of the earth," He made the spread of the Gospel and essential part of our Catholic life.

We urge you to respond generously to Fr. Tandoh's appeal.
